- Notify Tara Farm immediately in case of any illness or injury to horse.
- Notify veterinarian immediately if case of serious injury or serious illness to horse.
- Horse will never be turned out or unattended with halter on.

Tara Farm reserves the right to terminate this agreement at anytime. We understand that our goal is to place the rescue horse in a permanent home and will work with Tara Farm and perspective adoptive homes to achieve this. Tara Farm appreciates beyond words your support and willingness to help preserve and protect the lives of these horses. We promise to full fill the terms of this document.
